Upon receipt of this information prepared ship for action, unshipping ladders and awning stanchions and sending them out of the vessel, together with all paints and oils; shipped spare tiller and rove off relieving tackles, broke out sail locker and built barricades on topgallant forecastle with sails and awnings, secured...
