

The population has increased from 790,391 in 1900 to 1,657,155 persons in 1910, showing an increase of 866,764 or 109.7 per cent. The taxable wealth is now about \$800,000,000, and the value of farm and mineral products is more than \$150,000,000 per annum. The new state has 5,000 miles of railroad, 250,000 farms, more than 1,700 post offices and ninety or more towns and cities having more than 1,000 inhabitants. The meaning of the name Oklahoma, as explained by several authorities, is Red People, being composed of two pure Choctaw words, Okla, meaning people, and homma, red. In a treaty made in 1866 between the Federal Government and the commissioners appointed by the Choctaw, Chickasaw, Cherokee, Seminole and Creek Tribes, this name for the territory was agreed upon, and under this name it became a state. Eastern Oklahoma is the old Indian Territory, which borders on Missouri, Kansas and Arkansas, and is the timbered part of the state. About 1810 the emigration of the Cherokee Indians to the Indian Territory began, and between 1830 and 1840 the remainder of the Cherokees, the Creeks, Choctaws, Chlckasaws and Seniinoles moved there from their old homes in Georgia, Florida, the Carolinas and Alabama. For half a century the Federal Government attempted to hold the territory intact for the several Indian tribes, but eventually the time arrived when it became necessary to enter into new treaties, so as to make available for white settlement part of the country held ...
